Copyright serves as the guardian that protects this fragile economic ecosystem. Loosening the parameters of the Copyright Act, to enable increased copying and sharing of content, without paying for it, will see businesses close. Kiwis will lose their jobs. What's more, we risk losing the means to tell New Zealand's stories.
